

GENERAL SALON RULES

1. Entrants must be Active Members who are current on their dues. Such members are eligible to enter a maximum of three images in each of the club's four competition divisions.
2. Entry deadline is Noon Saturday, ten days before the salon date. The salon date is usually the first Tuesday of the month. (All dates are subject to change.)
3. Entries are to be delivered by the deadline to locations announced by the salon chairmen.
4. Exposures must be made by the entrant. Actual processing of film and prints may be done commercially, personally, or digitally (unless prohibited in a category).
5. Entries are scored from three to ten. Scores of 'three' are reserved for photographs submitted out-of-category. The judge need not use the entire range of possible scores.
6. Entries receiving a score of 8 points or higher are designated as **AWARD** winners.
7. All **AWARD** winning images:
 - receive a certificate,
 - are eligible for year-end awards, and
 - may *not* be entered in a future SPCC salon of the same division.
8. Images accepted in one division will continue to be eligible in the other divisions.
9. The identity of the judge shall not be disclosed to the general membership until the day of the salon.
10. Each entry shall be labeled with the member's name and title of the image.
11. The same slide, print, or digital image may not be entered in more than one monthly salon of the same division in a single competition year (October through May).
12. Non-award winning images may be re-entered in following competition years.
13. If you cannot attend the salon judging, please arrange to have someone else pick up your entries.
